How do I extend my student visa?

By applying for a long-term residence





DURING STUDIES – NON EU STUDENTS: FREE ACCESS TO THE LABOUR MARKET

- Only full-time students of accredited universities
- have free access to the Czech labour market
- Code 23 or 24 + certificate of study
- Primary reason for a student visa/residency is to
- study, not to work!
- No limit to number of hours at work or salary



DURING STUDIES – EU STUDENTS:

FREE ACCESS TO THE LABOUR MARKET

- No limit to number of hours at work or salary!
- You can work anywhere!

AFTER STUDIES – NON EU STUDENTS: FREE ACCESS TO THE LABOUR MARKET

- Successful graduates of accredited Czech universities have free access to the Czech labour market = don't need any work permit to work
- But need a residence permit to stay in CZ



WORK PERMIT & RESIDENCE PERMIT



AFTER STUDIES / GRADUATION - EU: FREE ACCESS TO THE LABOUR MARKET

• EU graduates don't need any work permit

• EU graduates don't need a permit to stay in CZ



STAY AFTER GRADUATION – NON EU

Two options:

- 1) Non-Dual Employee Card
- 2) Long-term residence with a purpose of seeking employment



STAY AFTER GRADUATION – NON EU

1. Long-term residence permit:

NON-DUAL EMPLOYEE CARD

- If you have already found a job and signed an
- employment contract
- You don't have to wait for an employee card
- approval to start working, start immediately



List of documents

1. NON-DUAL EMPLOYEE CARD

- Valid residence card and passport
- Proof of accommodation
- Employment contract
- Diploma or confirmation of graduation or completions of studies
- Valid medical insurance
- Photo



STAY AFTER GRADUATION

2. Long-term residence permit:

SEEKING EMPLOYMENT AND STARTING A BUSINESS

- If you don't have a job offer yet, you want to take some time
 off after graduation and look for a job
- You can work legally from the moment you sign a contract
- You can start business from the moment you get the licence
- Issued for 9 months and can't be extended



List of documents

2. SEEKING EMPLOYMENT AND STARTING A BUSINESS

- Valid residence card and passport
- Proof of accommodation
- Proof of finance (min 4860 CZK + rent/month)
- Diploma or confirmation of graduation or completions of studies
- Prepaid commercial medical insurance for foreigners for 9 months
- Photo





CHANGE FROM STUDIES

3. Long-term residence permit:

DUAL EMPLOYEE CARD

- Before graduate or when drop out of school
- If you have a stable job you like and you want to continue working there
- If your employer is willing to help you

3. DUAL EMPLOYEE CARD

- Valid residence card and passport
- Proof of accommodation
- Employment contract
- Vacancy number released by the Labor office (ask
- employer)
- Valid medical insurance
- Photo
